Larry Williams, DDS

Dr. Williams spent 30 years in the United States Navy where he provided dental care worldwide as a member of the Navy Dental Corps. He completed two residency programs and served in many positions such as an AEGD Director, Public Health Emergency Officer for FEMA Region 5, served on faculty positions at both medical and dental schools, and developed and taught substance abuse and addiction curriculum for the Navy, Department of Defense, VA, and other national and local programs. Dr. Williams also helped create the National Prevention Strategy for the Affordable Care Act. After retirement in 2012, he joined the faculty at Midwestern University College of Dental Medicine where he was recently promoted to Professor. His focus of academia is on the preclinical education of 1st and 2nd year dental students. Dr. Williams continues to also provide lectures on various topics to include a 16-hour lecture series that provides a comprehensive review of general dentistry, plus numerous topics to include geriatrics, poly pharmacy, office emergencies, pain control, anesthesia, and tobacco/vaping/cannabis. His research includes areas of public health to include anxiety, depression, disability, and aging with focus on the impact of these topics on the practice of dentistry.
